Risk	Risk Management
all	a. All students and leaders will be briefed on the nature of the planned walk and told that they must stay together as a group. If any part of the walk will occur during darkness the Instructor and each of the accompanying adults must carry a working torch.
1,3	b. Only routes approved by the Proprietor are to be used. Instructors are to be familiar with routes in both daylight and darkness before using with groups.
